Mt. Tremblant, Quebec

March 16-23, 2025

- Group pricing on accommodations at one of six hotels (your choice, 1-7 night stay, all hotels are in the pedestrian village with walk or cabriolet lift to the slopes) Our favorite hotels are shown below. More info is on the Tremblant website.

Hotel Sommet des Neiges lies right at the base of Tremblant, at the upper end of the pedestrian village, allowing ski in/out access to the slopes. The hotel offers 1-3 BR suites, each with a full kitchen for guests who prefer to prepare their own meals or avoid a crowd. Amenities include an outdoor hot tub, sauna, fitness room, ski and snowboard lockers, wifi, and concierge service. At the current exchange rate of 0.75US dollar to 1 Canadian dollar
1 BR King +sofa bed ~\$868 USD + tax room rental for 6 nights
2 BR K/Q +sofa bed ~\$1426 USD + tax room for 6 nights
3 BR 3Q ~ \$1935 USD + tax room for 6 nights



Le Lodge de la Montagne is just downhill from Sommet des Neiges, still at the upper end of the pedestrian village. It has hotel rooms OR suites with small kitchens. Amenities include an outdoor pool, indoor and outdoor hot tubs, sauna, fitness room, lockers and wifi. You can ski in/out via the trail running through the pedestrian village. At the current exchange rate of 0.75 US dollar to 1 Canadian dollar
Hotel room ~\$666 USD +tax room rental for 6 nights
1BR suite ~\$841 USD + tax room for 6 nights
2 BR suite ~\$1219 USD + tax room for 6 nights



Mt. Tremblant has been perennially ranked the number one ski resort in the east. The mountain boasts 2116 vertical feet, 102 trails on 755 acres with 14 lifts. Trails encircle the mountain on both north and south faces. There is ample skiing for all levels including 22 novice, 31 intermediate and 49 expert slopes (and 178 acres of glades). The spectacular pedestrian village creates ample opportunity for dining, shopping and entertainment. Nothing like it in the east! There are numerous off slope activities including cross country skiing, snowshoeing, fondue/snowshoe, snowmobiles, dog sledding, ice fishing, ice climbing, winter zipline, and a small casino.

Additional info:

Savings! The US – Canadian exchange rate is usually around \$ 0.75 USD to \$1 Canadian. Hotel reservations and group ticket reservations will be made by each individual using a group code which will be supplied to you upon sign up. The late March trip timing offers longer days, warmer temps and much reduced lodging costs (avoiding the Quebec and Ontario school holidays). Tremblant offers a generous \$0 fee cancellation policy up to 3d before the trip for any reason. Our group rates are about ½ the public rates!
